The PMDC comprises a complete data centre infrastructure, including IT equipment, Eaton's UPS system, a chiller unit, and fire detection and suppression systems. It enables easy expansion of existing data centre floor space without the need for major construction or building retrofit.

Built inside shipping containers of 20, 40 or 53 feet (6, 12 or 16 metres), the PMDC delivers high-density compute-processing and provides a fully operational, movable data centre that can be shipped and rapidly deployed at virtually any location, expanding the existing data-processing capability in remote or temporary environments.

The PMDC offers a complete physical infrastructure incorporating Eaton power quality and power distribution products: Along with the scalable Eaton 9395 UPS – which protects power with its small footprint, low weight and ability to achieve 99 per cent efficiency with Energy Saver System (ESS) technology – the PMDC also incorporates a complete Eaton UPS and ePDU selection as well as busbars, switchgears and large PDUs from Eaton Electrical.

"The PMDC is part of IBM's strategy to deliver a cost – effective and flexible family of modular data centre solutions to businesses facing significant capital and operational costs," says Steve Sams, IBM Vice President, Global Site and Facilities Services.

### PMDC touring Europe

Eaton worked with IBM to install a unit in Spain that features an Eaton 550 kVA UPS (N+1 configuration) with 20 minutes of battery runtime and associated switchgear. This installation also features a onemegawatt diesel generator as part of the electrical infrastructure.
